Modi's visit to Bangladesh will be very memorable: Jaishankar

Dhaka, Mar 5: Prime Minister Narendra Modi's planned visit to Dhaka later this month will surely be a "very memorable" one, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said on Thursday, as he described India's strategic ties with Bangladesh a truly "360 degree partnership".

Jaishankar arrived here in the morning on a day-long visit to prepare the ground for Prime Minister Modi's visit to Bangladesh later this month to participate in the celebrations of 50th anniversary of Bangladesh's Independence and 50

years of Bangladesh-India diplomatic relations.

After holding comprehensive discussions with his Bangladeshi counterpart A K Abdul Momen, Jaishankar said Bangladesh was central to India's 'Neighbourhood First' policy and increasingly relevant to the country's 'Act East Policy'.

"We are working to prepare for the planned visit of our Prime Minister. It will surely be a very memorable visit: if I recall right it would be his first visit outside India since the coronavirus pandemic and his second as Prime

Minister to Bangladesh," he told reporters at a joint press conference along with Momen.

"Many of you would remember his (Modi's) last visit (here), that was something very transformational in our relationship," he said.

Prime Minister Modi is likely to pay a two day visit to Dhaka from March 26 to Bangladesh to participate in a series of events.

Jaishankar called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and extended Prime Minister Modi's good wishes to her. He also conveyed to her that that Modi looks forward

to visiting Bangladesh soon.

"Thank PM Sheikh Hasina for receiving me today. Conveyed warm greetings of PM @narendramodi. Her sagacity and leadership continues to inspire our relationship," he tweeted after the meeting.

Earlier, Jaishankar acknowledged that it was a "very special year" for the people of Bangladesh when both countries mark the Mujib Barsho, 50 years of Bangladesh's Liberation and 50 years of India-Bangladesh bilateral relationship.

"May all your dreams come true and I can assure you that India will always be there by your side, as a reliable friend," he said.

Taking parents for vaccination shot trends

New Delh, Mar 5: As the elderly population of the country are currently getting vaccinated against COVID-19, many social media users are professing their love for their parents with some expressing it with a shot of healthy humour.

The Twitterati particularly was expressive and phrases like "mom gets first shot" and "took dad for vaccination" have been floating on the micro-blogging site with #Covid19 hashtag.

Twitter user @ladybirdsgf shared a screenshot of a phone chat with her mother.

"Pretty crazy way for

my mom to announce her vaccination - 'got shots', 'it was painless', she tweeted quoting her mother's messages.

The profile picture showed a selfie of the user with her mother.

Another user @goyalatanushree said, "My parents are on the covid vaccination list at our home in Delhi and for the first time in ages - I am truly overjoyed. Fingers crossed!" Delhi-based Svetta Mohla shared a photo of her with her mother after the vaccination.

"Mother's first vaccine dose administered," she posted on Facebook.

But some posts on Twitter sought to inject a

healthy dose of humour amid the ongoing vaccination exercise's second phase, meant for the elderly population.

User NareshKataria14 shared a poster with a humour-laced message, "For the first time in the history of the mankind, no kids are taking parents for vaccination." Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal got vaccinated on Thursday, along with his parents, all three taking their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine, even as he appealed to all eligible people to come forward and get vaccinated, asserting that there's "nothing to fear".

The vaccine was first administered to Kejriwal's parents, Govind Ram Kejriwal and Gita Devi, and then to the chief minister at the government-run Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan hospital here.

They all were given the Covishield vaccine.

"I and my parents got our first dose of COVID-19 vaccine today. We had no problems and are perfectly healthy. There is nothing to fear. Doubts in people's mind (about the vaccine) no longer exist. I appeal to everyone eligible for the vaccine to come and get themselves vaccinated," Kejriwal told reporters after getting the jab.

He also tweeted pictures of getting his vaccine shots and a video of him with his parents.

During the second-phase of the inoculation drive that started on March 1, people aged 60 years and above and those in the 45-59 age group with specific comorbidities are being administered the vaccine at 192 hospitals across Delhi.

Inspired by Star Trek, Indian-American scientist tells Biden

Washington, Mar 5: Indian-American aerospace engineer Swati Mohan, who played a key role in the successful landing of NASA's Perseverance rover on the Martian surface, told President Joe Biden on Thursday that her path to the US space agency began when she watched the first episode of Star Trek as a child.

Mohan leads the guidance, navigation, and control operations of NASA's Mars 2020 mission. She played a pivotal role in landing the US space agency's historic Perseverance rover on the Martian surface on February 18. Mohan was also the first to confirm that the rover had successfully touched down on the Martian surface after surviving a particularly tricky plunge through the atmosphere of the Red Planet.

Mohan, who emigrated from India to the US when she was only a year old, said her path actually started way

back when she was a child, watching popular TV show Star Trek.

"In addition to those fantastical scenes of space, what really captured my attention was this really close-knit team which was working together, manipulating this technological marvel with the sole purpose of exploring space and understanding new things and seeking new life," Mohan told Biden during a virtual interaction.

President Biden on Thursday congratulated the NASA team responsible for last month's successful landing of the six-wheeled rover on Mars and for giving the country a "dose of confidence" at a moment when the nation's reputation as a scientific leader has been tattered by the coronavirus pandemic.

"Those last days and weeks leading up to landing day, it was pretty smooth, but we were all still really nervous and, frankly, terrified until we

got through those final seven minutes. To be able to call touchdown safely, to see those first images come back from Mars, to see the place where we have never been able to go to on Mars before and go there - reach there for the express purpose of seeking out new life just made it feel like I was living in a dream," said the Indian-American engineer.

"I tell you what, you said you feel like you're 'living a dream' - you've created a dream for millions and millions of young kids, young Americans. You talk about STEM. You - it was - look, the thing that I found so exhilarating about this: You all did this - the whole team - the team I can see now and the entire team at JPL - what you did: You restored a dose of confidence in the American people," Biden responded.

Beijing, Mar 5: China on Friday hiked its defence budget to \$ 209 billion, maintaining a single-digit growth for the sixth consecutive year with a 6.8 per cent increase in 2021.

The budget hike was announced by Chinese Premier Li Keqiang at the country's Parliament, the National People's Congress (NPC).

Defending the increase, Zhang Yesui, spokesperson for the NPC, told the media here that China's efforts to strengthen the national defence do not target or threaten any country.

Whether a country poses a threat to others depends on what kind of defence policy it pursues, he said, adding that China is committed to the path of peaceful development and adheres to a defence policy that is defensive in nature.
