Modi to officially send-off Olympics-bound Indian team

New Delhi, June 13: In a bid to boost the morale of the country’s Olympic-bound athletes, Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to accord an official send-off to the Indian contingent tentatively between July 10 and 15.

According to a source in the Sports Ministry, the Indian contingent is expected to leave the country a day after the official send-off ceremony.

“The Prime Minister is expected to give the official send-off to the Olympic-bound athletes to boost their morale. The date for the ceremony is yet to finalised but it is expected to be anytime between July 10-15,” the ministry source told PTI.

The source confirmed that the send-off will only be for those athletes who are currently based in the country and will

fly out from here.

“The send-off will be for those athletes who will fly to Tokyo from India. Athletes who are already out of the country for competition or training will fly directly to Tokyo from their respective places,” he said.

He further informed that any person other than athletes, coaches and support staff, who

are required to travel to Tokyo for the Games, will be granted permission as per requirement.

The official reiterated that the ministry has decided against sending its delegation to Tokyo Olympics to accommodate “maximum” support staff, including coaches and physios, for the athletes competing in the Summer Games in the wake of the ongoing

COVID-19 situation worldwide.

As per the norms, the number of officials travelling to Olympics cannot be more than one-third of the athletes’ contingent.

A total of 100 Indian athletes have so far qualified and another 25 to 35 might make the cut for the Tokyo Olympics scheduled from July 23 to August 8.

Weightlifter Mirabai qualifies

The International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) on Saturday confirmed that star Indian lifter Mirabai Chanu has qualified for the upcoming Tokyo Olympics in the women’s 49kg category.

Mirabai, the 2017 world champion in weightlifting, had secured her place in Tokyo by winning a bronze medal in the Asian Championship in Tashkent in April with a world record in clean and jerk.

The 26-year-old from Manipur has qualified on the basis of her standings on IWF’s Absolute Ranking list. The Indian lifter is ranked second in the 49kg category.

“Many congratulations to #TOPSAthlete weightlifter @mirabai_chanu who has qualified for #Tokyo2020 after @iwfnet published its Absolute Ranking list where she is placed 2nd in the women’s 49 kg,” Sports Authority of India (SAI) tweeted.

UK-EU Brexit standoff casts shadow on G7 summit

Falmouth, June 13: Turbulence from the divorce between the UK and the European Union provided an unwanted distraction at the Group of Seven (g7) summit taking place in southwest England, with British Prime Minister Boris Johnson saying Saturday that post-Brexit agreements will fail if the EU continues to take a theologically draconian approach to the rules.

Johnson held meetings with German Chancellor Angela Merkel, French President Emmanuel Macron and the bloc’s top officials on the sidelines of the summit he is hosting.

Afterwards, the prime minister claimed the EU was not taking a sensible or pragmatic approach to post-Brexit arrangements, and he threatened to use an emergency clause to suspend agreed upon rules if the bloc did not compromise.

Britain and the EU are locked in an escalating diplomatic feud over Northern Ireland, the only part of the U.K. that borders the 27-nation bloc. The EU is angry over the British government’s delay in implementing new checks on some goods coming into Northern Ireland from the rest of the U.K., while Britain says the

checks are imposing a big burden on businesses and destabilising Northern Ireland’s hard-won peace.

U.S. President Joe Biden has gotten drawn into the spat, raising concerns about the potential threat to Northern Ireland’s peace accord.

The new arrangements, designed to keep an open border between Ireland and its northern neighbour, have angered Northern Ireland’s British unionists, who say they weaken ties with the rest of the UK. Tensions over the new trade rules were a contributing factor to a week of street violence in April,

largely in unionist areas of Northern Ireland, that saw youths pelt police with bricks, fireworks and firebombs.

European Commission President Ursula Von der Leyen tweeted after meeting Johnson that Northern Ireland peace was paramount, and the binding Brexit agreement protected it. We want the best possible relations with the UK. Both sides must implement what we agreed on. There is complete EU unity on this, she said.

Johnson told Sky News at the summit site in Carbis Bay, Cornwall, that the treaty we signed, I signed, is perfectly reasonable, but he added: I don’t think that the interpretation or application of the protocol (by the EU) is sensible or pragmatic.

UK to defer unlock by four weeks due to spike

London, June 13: The UK government is considering a delay of up to four weeks from the scheduled June 21 end to all lockdown restrictions amid a continuing rise in cases of the Delta variant of COVID-19, according to a media report on Saturday.

It comes as the country reported 8,125 new COVID-19 cases in a 24-hour period, another record daily high since the end of February, and Public Health England (PHE) found that infections from the Delta variant the B.1.617.2 variant of concern (VOC) first identified in India rose by nearly 30,000 in a week to hit 42,323.

Downing Street sources told the BBC that no final decision has been made yet and that several options are being evaluated as the latest data is studied before UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson makes a

scheduled announcement regarding lockdown on Monday.

Asked about Monday’s announcement in Cornwall on the sidelines of the G7 Summit, Johnson told the BBC it was important to ensure any easing of restrictions was “irreversible”.

“What I can certainly say is we are looking at the data, continuing to do that, but what you can certainly take is the roadmap was always cautious but irreversible, and in order to have an irreversible roadmap, we’ve got to be cautious,” said Johnson.

“Again you have hospitalisations up, you’ve got cases up. There are grounds for caution. That doesn’t mean that this country hasn’t made enormous progress with vaccination. Clearly what we have is a race between the vaccines and the virus and the vaccines are going to win.

So it’s just a question of the pace,” he said.

The British Medical Association (BMA) is among some of the leading public healthcare groups and officials calling for a delay to the planned easing of all lockdown restrictions on June 21, dubbed Freedom Day as it would see all legal limits on social contact removed. Pushing the date back by a few weeks is intended to allow the country’s vaccination programme to take greater effect, as the rollout moves through to younger age groups and the older age groups get covered with their second jabs.

“It’s not just about the number of hospitalisations, but also the risk to the health of large numbers of younger people, who can suffer long-term symptoms,” said BMA council chairman Dr. Chaand Nagpaul.

Inspired by Novotna, Krejcikova wins Roland Garros title

Paris, June 13: Thinking of her late coach the whole time, Barbora Krejcikova went from unseeded to Grand Slam champion at the French Open.

Krejcikova beat 31st-seeded Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova 6-1, 2-6, 6-4 in the final at Roland Garros on Saturday to win the title in just her fifth major tournament as a singles player.

When it ended with Pavlyuchenkova’s backhand landing long on the fourth match point for Krejcikova, a 25-year-old from the Czech Republic, they met at the net for a hug.

Then Krejcikova blew kisses, her eyes squeezed shut, in tribute to her former coach, Jana Novotna, the 1998 Wimbledon champion who died of cancer in 2017.

“Pretty much her last words were just enjoy and just try to win a Grand Slam. And, I mean, I know that, from somewhere, she’s looking after me,” Krejcikova told the crowd at Court Philippe Chatrier, limited to 5,000 because of the coronavirus pandemic.

“All of this that just happened, these two weeks, is pretty much because she is just looking after me from up there,” Krejcikova said, lifting her left hand toward the sky.

Indian-origin healthcare expert in Queen’s honour list

London, June 13: Indian-origin healthcare expert involved in the field of COVID-19 vaccine trials and community support efforts is among those in the spotlight at the Queen’s Birthday Honours List.

The Queen’s Birthday Honours List, unveiled on Friday evening, is released every year to coincide with Queen Elizabeth II’s official birthday celebrations held during the second weekend of June. This time, it has a special focus on the extraordinary efforts made by individuals across the country during the pandemic.

Kolkata-born Divya Chadha Manek has been honoured with an Order of the British Empire (OBE) for services to the government during the COVID-19 response for her involvement in the research and development of vaccines and the resulting clinical trials.

Chadha Manek, now the director of business development and marketing at the British government’s National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Clinical Research Network, was at the heart of ensuring that COVID-19 vaccines could be put through requisite trials for a timely deployment as the Clinical Trials Workstream lead at the UK’s Vaccine Taskforce.

“To me, this honour is recognising not just me, but everyone involved in the success of UK vaccine research -- the half-a-million people who signed up to the

vaccine research registry and the tens of thousands who took part in the vital COVID-19 vaccine trials here,” said Chadha Manek, who moved to the UK as a teenager with a simple message from her Punjabi father. Others across different fields honoured with an OBE include Jagjit Singh Chadha, director of the National Institute of Economic and Social Research, for services to economics and economic policy; actress and writer Lolita Chakrabarti for services to drama; and Sumita Singha for services to architecture.

Those receiving MBEs include Vimalkumar Choksi, Councillor, Ashton Waterlo, Tameside, for services to the community in Greater Manchester; Gurveer Dhami, senior private secretary to the Secretary of State For Education, and Amika Sara George, Founder of #FreePeriods Campaign, both for services to education; Sumit Goyal, consultant oncoplastic surgeon, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board, for services to breast cancer and Cardiff Breast Centre Charity; and Priya Guha, Venture Partner, Merian Ventures, and Member, Innovate UK Council, for services to international trade and women-led innovation.

When Suburban services are back to their packed pre COVID-19 schedule the trains will appear cleaner than they used to be as railways is using the lockdown time to setup automatic coach washing plants at EMU car sheds at Avadi and Tambaram. These are in addition to the one that is being setup for long distance trains at Tambaram yard.

This will be the first time suburban trains will be driven through the rotating brushes of automatic washing plants that can control wastage of water installed at the pitlines where coaches are maintained and readied for the trip.

The automatic plants ensure that the rakes are clean and water is saved. It also reduces the expense of maintaining trains.

Indian Railways will be setting up 126 such plants across the country in 29 locations.
