The Pillion's Head..!

This morning as I looked out of my window, I saw a scooterist skidding. No pleasant sight as the bike rattled like a helpless animal and the rider fell heavily to the ground. Luckily, he was wearing a helmet, but the box he was carrying in the rear flew in the air, and burst open as it hit the ground.

Horrorstricken, I wondered, had it been a pillion rider, what could have happened?

Two months ago, the Maharashtra government decided to enforce the rule that it was mandatory for a pillion to wear a helmet. This month, with a new government and a new police chief, they've decided to 'go slow' on the rule.

"It's quite a nuisance" it was quoted. "To carry two helmets!"

I could write a couple of columns on the 'nuisance' value of two helmets, compared to looking at a dead or braindead pillion, but I won't today. Instead, what struck me, was that thousands of riders in the city insisted their pillions started wearing helmets, when the rule was being enforced, not

because they suddenly started caring for the person behind, but afraid of the policemen.

Only fear of the law, makes us observe safety measures in our country.

Only fear of getting caught makes us obey rules. Once, while in Austria, everybody in the restaurant I was dining in, ran out. I was puzzled, and thinking something catastrophic had happened, sauntered outside to find people shaking their heads and walking back in. "What happened?" I asked, seeing no signs of an accident.

"A motorist blew his horn!" said my companion.

They had all run out because someone had done the unheard, of blowing his horn.

In a polite society that was a rude gesture, and something that called for instant disapproval, which they had shown to the driver with their frowns.

I've seen this politeness at junctions abroad, while driving on

highways and almost everywhere; a politeness that transcends rules, that comes out of a simple thought, that of "consideration for the other person!"

We don't seem to have much of such thinking here. We have loudspeakers that go on, even after the ten-o'clock deadline, and stop only after someone complains and if when the police arrive! Do we ever think about elders and children spending a disturbed and sleepless night because of that loud sound?

Only when the rider values the head of his or her pillion, only when we do things because we are concerned about others, will we change for the better in our country.

Many years ago, a spiritual leader went about saying, there were only two laws worth following, one about loving God, and the other, "Love thy neighbour as thyself!"

"Rider! Look at your immediate neighbour, riding pillion, and in love, get that second helmet..!"

Chennai, Aug 13: Two young and highly talented cueists - trainees of Chennai-based Saleem Snooker Academy (SSA) - are heading to Romania for the World Snooker Championship to be held from August 15.

The International Billiards and Snooker Federation (IBSF) is conducting the U-16, U-18 and U-21 World Championships in Bucharest, Romania from Monday. The two SSA trainees - Anupama Ramachandran and Laxmi Narayanan - who

have been practicing hard with multiple time Tamil Nadu Champion and former India No.3 S.A.Saleem at the SSA, have been have been selected to represent India in the World Championship.

Anupama Ramachandran is also eligible to represent India in the Womens-6 Red World Championship to be held in Malaysia in October and the Womens-15 Red Snooker Championship at Turkey in November this year.

Laxmi Narayanan, a 11th Class student of

Velammal Vidhyashram, Mambakkam has been training under Saleem for the last 2 years and has finished India No 4 in U-16 Category. At a press conference held at the SSA, ahead of his departure for New Delhi from where he would leave for Romania on Saturday with three other Indians selected to participate in the event, Narayanan exuded confidence of a good showing in the World Stage.

"It's a big opportunity and I hope to do well. I have been training

hard under Saleem. Sir ad has given some key tips on how to handle any pressure and I look forward to do well in Romania," Narayanan, who is Tamil Nadu No 2 in U-21 Billiards, Tamil Nadu No 3 in U-18 Billiards, Tamil Nadu No.4 in U-18 Snooker and All India Top 16 in U 18 and U 21 Billiards, said.

Anupama, who will leave for Romania one or two days later, is currently ranked Number one India after the Selection camp held in Bangalore in June.
